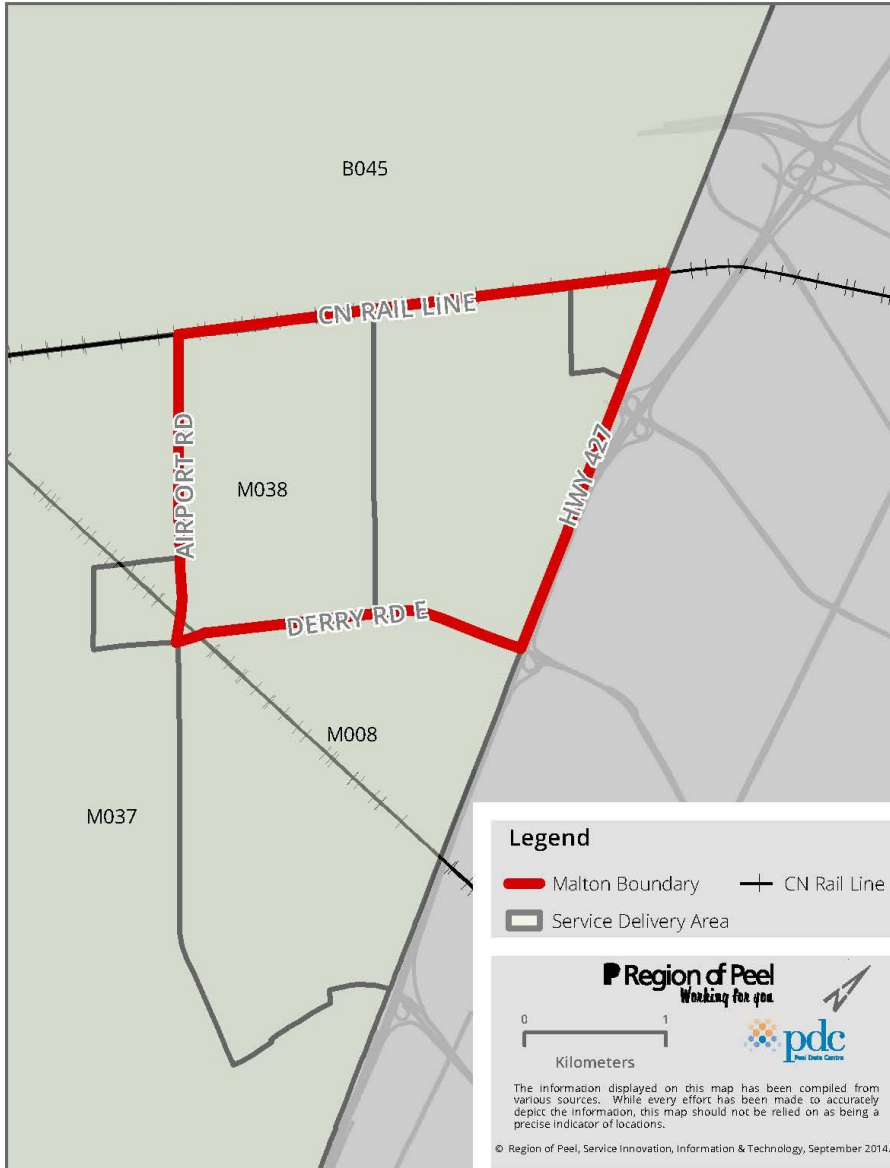


The Community of Malton in Mississauga



- Malton is one of the five Peel communities where Peel Newcomer Strategy Group is working with the local institutions and organization to develop a coordinated **Service Delivery Network (SDN)** that meets the needs of this particular community.

- Malton Neighbourhood Services** is playing a facilitating role to bring together all the stakeholders in this community together.

The population of the Malton neighbourhood was 38,700 in 2011 with **36.2%** of its residents moving in the 5 years (either moving into Malton or out of it). In Malton, 6.1% of residents do not speak an official language. The top 3 languages spoken across this neighbourhood are Punjabi (17.0%), Gujarati (3.5%) and Urdu (1.3%). The **top 5 visible minorities** are: South Asian (47.3%), Black (17.7%), Latin American (2.9%), Filipino (1.7%) and West Asian (1.3%).

The income groups are as follows:

Under \$5,000 – 21.3% (6,455)
 \$5,000-\$39,999 – 63.2% (19,175)
 \$40,000 - \$79,999 – 14.9% (4,515)
 \$80,000 and over – 0.6% (195)

Additionally, **31.8%** (9,645) of residents spend 30% or more of their household total income on shelter costs.
