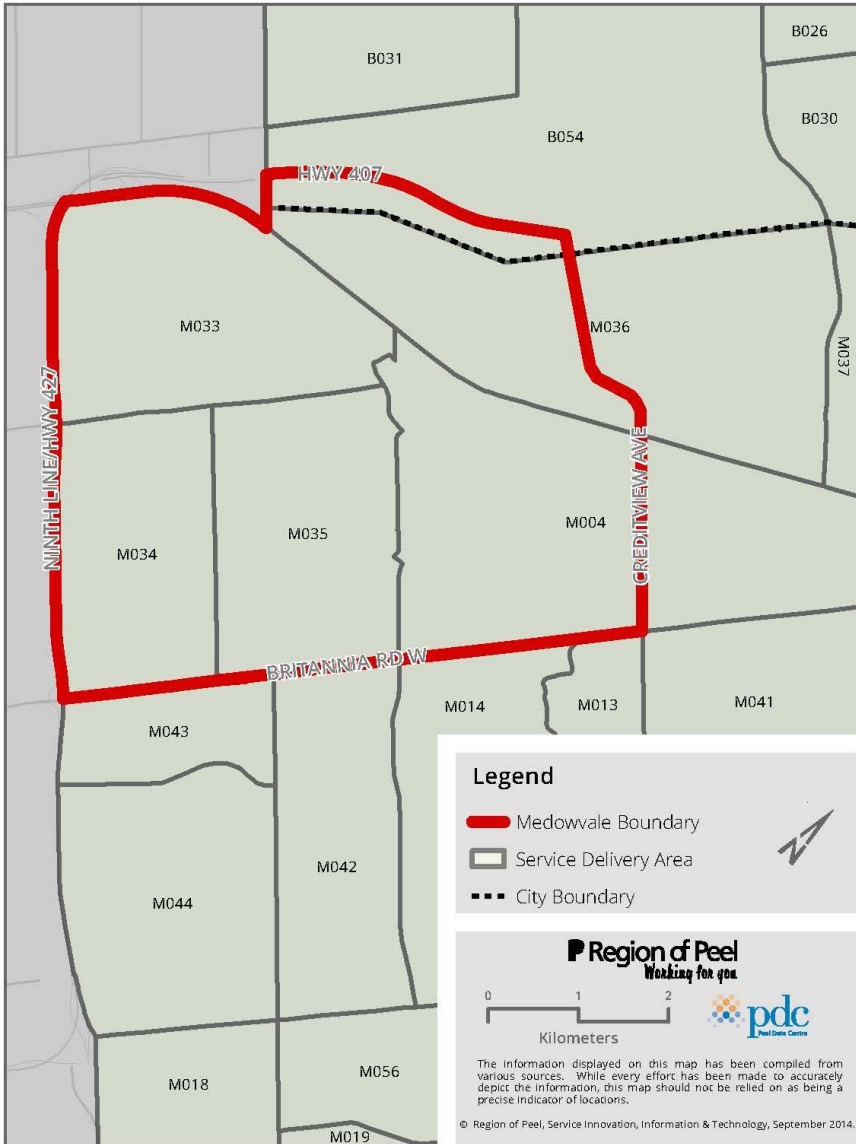


# The Community of Meadowvale in Mississauga



- Meadowvale is one of the five Peel communities where Peel Newcomer Strategy Group is working with the local institutions and organization to develop a coordinated **Service Delivery Network (SDN)** that meets the needs of this particular community.

- **Peel Multicultural Council** is playing a facilitating role to bring together all the stakeholders in this community together.

The population of the Meadowvale community was 105,205 in 2011 with **30.1%** of its residents moving in the last 5 years (either moving into Meadowvale or out of it). In Meadowvale, 2.1% (2,230) of its residents do not speak an official language. The top 3 languages spoken across this neighbourhood are: Urdu (2.8%), Polish (1.0%) and Spanish (1.0%). The **top 5 visible minorities** are: South Asian (20.0%), Black (6.5%), Filipino (5.5%), Chinese (4.7%) and Arab (3.0%).

The income groups are as follows:

Under \$5,000 – 19.4% (16,225)  
 \$5,000-\$39,999 – 44.6% (37,265)  
 \$40,000 - \$79,999 – 29.6% (24,705)  
 \$80,000 and over – 6.4% (5,330)

Additionally, **23.0%** (19,230) of residents spend 30% or more of their household total income on shelter costs.
