

The Community of Sheridan-Clarkson in Mississauga



- Sheridan-Clarkson is one of the five Peel communities where Peel Newcomer Strategy Group is working with the local institutions and organization to develop a coordinated **Service Delivery Network (SDN)** that meets the needs of this particular community.

- **Polycultural Immigrant & Community Services** is playing a facilitating role to bring together all the stakeholders in this community together.

The population of the **Sheridan-Clarkson** community was 16,740 in 2011 with 30.1% of its residents moving in the last 5 years (either moving into Sheridan or out of it). In Sheridan, 2.2% (345) of residents do not speak an official language, the top 3 languages spoken across this neighbourhood are: Urdu (4.6%), Polish (1.9%) and Farsi (1.3%). The **top 5 visible minorities** are: South Asian (16.0%), Chinese (5.4%), Black (4.2%), Filipino (3.2%) and West Asian (2.6%).

The income groups are as follows:

Under \$5,000 – 18.5% (2,430)
 \$5,000-\$39,999 – 47.6% (6,245)
 \$40,000 - \$79,999 – 24.0% (3,145)
 \$80,000 and over – 9.9% (1,300)

Additionally, **21.6%** (2,835) of residents spend 30% or more of their household total income on shelter costs.
